Role Description

We are looking for a dedicated Policy and Strategy Volunteer to work with the President/CEO on the design and writing of the AHO Strategic Plan 2020 – 2030 for the delivery of capacity building programmes and anticipating future as well as current health and social care needs in Africa.

Purpose of role

The role provides expert evidence and policy advice to the President/CEO in writing Strategic Plan 2020 – 2030 and develops clear evidence-based policy positions on health issues in Africa. The role is responsible for shaping the development of the charity's incipient Strategic Plan 2020 – 2030 for international health work.

Specific Responsibilities

A. Policy

1. To research and analyse information relevant to inclusion in the Strategic Plan 2020 – 2030.
2. Analyse and review all available information and recommend options of policies in the Plan.

B. Strategy

- i. To support the President/CEO to write Africa Health Organisation (AHO) Strategic Plan 2020 – 2030 covering details of our Strategic Objectives as the book's chapters such as:
 - 1) To combat Communicable Diseases such as TB, HIV/AIDS, malaria, cholera, diarrhoea, sepsis, etc
 - 2) To tackle Noncommunicable Diseases such as cancer, diabetes, kidney failure, hypertension, etc
 - 3) To address determinants of health and risk factors such as gender, equity, equality, alcohol, etc
 - 4) To modernise health system and health service such as modernisation agenda, quality care, etc
 - 5) To improve preparedness, surveillance and response such as risk assessment, crisis, wars, etc
 - 6) To provide high quality care for all such as personalisation agenda, participation, etc
 - 7) To improve nutrition, food safety and food security such as climate change, drought strategy etc
 - 8) To build a skilled health workforce such as availability, quality, specialists such as cardiologists etc
 - 9) To improve access to medical products and technology such as essential medicines, imaging, etc
 - 10) To develop good governance and corporate services such as leadership, procurement, etc
- ii. To produce the final copy and send to UK government, embassies and to captains of the industries
